This Advent season our theme has been "From Generation to Generation," which comes from Mary's song of protest and praise:

Surely, from now on all generations will call me blessed; For the Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name. His mercy is for those who fear him **from generation to generation.** (Luke 1:48b-50)

We are invited to look at the characters in our scriptures and wonder: What did each character pass on or contribute? How did each character participate in God's liberation and love?

As I have prepared my sermons, and prayed on this theme, I have wondered how future generations might remember me. What attributes, passions, and actions will I be known for? What seeds am I planting for the future? How about you?

From Generation to Generation . . . reminds us of the ways our lives, histories, actions, and stories are

interconnected and woven together. In the midst of a world narrative that is designed to divide us, what does it look like to practice belonging to one another? For the work of God is always unfolding - in and through us. This Advent season, how will we carry it forth?


