


Items needed:



Carl Andrew's Delicious Rhubarb Dessert

1/2 c Margarine	1 tsp Baking soda	1 Egg	½ tsp Salt
½ c Sugar	1 tsp Vanilla	1 c Buttermilk	2 ½ c Flour
3-4 c Sliced Rhubarb	1 c Brown Sugar	1/2 c Chopped Wo	alnuts

Grease a 13x9 pan. Mix the first 8 ingredients together. Add Rhubarb and pour into the pan. Sprinkle brown sugar and nuts over the cake. Bake for 50 minutes at 350.

Optional Topping:½ c Margarine1 c Sugar1 tsp vanilla½ c Sweet Condensed MilkStir over heat until the sugar dissolves. Pour on top of cooled cake.

REPORTS:

Secretary's Report: Edit to June 9th Minutes: **Financial Security:** Two people shall be present for safe deposits. Received after edit.

Advent: Advent will start Sun, Nov 24th. We will have 3 Midweek services, alternating with Resurrection (Dec 4, 11, & 18th). Place to be determined once the confirmation schedule is set.

Snow Removal: Snow removal from church sidewalks and parsonage and grass cutting at the parsonage was discussed. Charlie will speak to Josh about the additional responsibilities.

OLD BUSINESS:

Financial Security: The combination to the safe will be changed every 2 months. **Church Lighting Proposals:** Todd reported that \$372.00 needs to be added to the retrofit for the new workshop lights. All approved. **Brat Barn Update:** The July 27th Brat Barn brought in \$840.00. The September 14th fundraiser will need more volunteers, especially frying.

Worship and Picnic at Resurrection on August 18th: There will be a joint 10:00a.m. worship. Tents will be set-up, but bring a dish to pass and your own lawn chair. Help is needed for clean-up.

Concern for Our Neighbor 2024: We still need a Thrivent Grant (update: now have). Tree tags can be removed for items needed.


