



### Impact of the 2024 MobilePack

On behalf of the Feed My Starving

Children's Green Bay Mobile Pack Partner Board, we would like to thank everyone for their donations and support. Bethel raised \$1,130 with the Angel Board donations and \$262 on the basket raffle. Along with the \$135 in miscellaneous donations from our honor and remembrance envelopes, we were able to donate \$1527!! That amount pays for 5265 meals, which will feed 14 children for an entire year!!

As a grand total, 520,992 meals were packed at the Green Bay Community Church during the 4 day Mobile Pack. This will feed 1,427 kids for an entire year. To make this possible, 2,797 volunteers worked side-by-side in various roles and capacities - all with one goal -

feeding God's starving children, in both body and spirit. If you were able to be there to help, we hope you had a wonderful time and we hope to see you again next year!! Maybe you weren't able to be there but supported us with your prayers. All is greatly appreciated!! When we know where all the food that was assembled at our Mobile Pack is sent, we will let you know.

Invite Someone to Church: This will be repeated on All Saints Sunday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>.


**Adjourn:** Todd made a motion to adjourn at 8:35pm. Seconded by Pastor Kim. Closed with the Lord's Prayer.
