# Aebleskiver Fest 2025 in the Books!

### Here are the final numbers:

We served 574 adults and 34 children.

48 batches of Aebleskiver batter were made, which equals 3,120 Aebleskivers.

160 pounds of sausage were cooked and 700 cups of coffee were served. 35 baskets were sold totalling \$3,971 and sales from the event were \$6,743 totalling \$10,714 in net proceeds.

# Special Congregational Meeting: Pew and Altar Refreshing Sunday, April 13th at 10 am

The Council is calling a special meeting on April 13th immediately following the Palm Sunday service. The only item on the agenda will be to discuss refreshing of the pews, lecture, pulpit and altar. This project, which will cost under \$7,000, was passed unanimously at our last council meeting. I strongly encourage your attendance at this important meeting.

Monday, March 17, 2025

**Present:** Pastor Kim Swenson, Cindy Michalski, Doris Brack, Linda Wery, Pegi Be Dell, Todd Keckhaver and Charlie Hilla. **Excused:** Tim Moran, Gayle Peot

**Call to Order:** Cindy called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

**Dwelling in the Word:** Pr Kim led with a question from the lenten *Everything in Between* devotional cards. This led to sharing time when we sensed a message from others that we did not belong and the long-term effect it had. Pastor Kim led us in prayer.

#### **REPORTS:**

**Secretary's Report:** Received as submitted.

**Parish Accountant Report:** Some long-inactive accounts have been closed and the balances of \$82.30 transferred to the Mission Reserve Account. Report received as submitted. Motion was made to transfer \$1,000 from the Special Fund – Tradition Innovation to Aebleskiver – Community Efforts. Motion passed. Motion was made to transfer half of the ministry savings to the American Funds-Money Market. Motion passed. We are awaiting to make a contribution to FMSC, to see if there will be a matching funds drive closer to the fall Pack.

**Pastor's Report:** Pastor Kim handed out a flyer for the April 5<sup>th</sup> Racial Justice Conference at Ascension encouraging more people to attend. Report received as submitted.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

**Synod Benevolence:** After discussion, a motion was passed to send \$4,000 for the first quarter of 2025. **Stamp Out Hunger:** Saturday, May 10, 2025, Resurrection Pantry will participate in this event. At least two more volunteers are needed to drive around a designated route to pick-up food left by resident mailboxes. Then at approximately 12:30pm, volunteers are needed to meet at the Post Office to divide the collection. The more volunteers we have, the more food will be allocated to the pantry. ### **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Aebleskiver:** We give thanks for the many years of service by April and Mike Martin. Discussion on setting up a committee to help oversee the fundraiser for next year as it is too much for one person. Therefore, a meeting will be held on May 4, 2025, to organize committees on shifts, clean-up crew, announcements, baskets, food, etc.

**Tree Removal:** Charlie will call Diggers Hotline and Todd will investigate who originally installed electricity to the electric sign. Then stump grinding will be scheduled. After completion, Buildings & Grounds will clean up debris.


**Sanctuary Flooring Repairs:** HJ Martin will be here Thursday March 20<sup>th</sup> to repair the floor area from the pew reconfiguration.

**Pew Refurbishing:** Charlie received an estimate of \$6,975 from Sherri Koclan to refurbish the pews, pulpit, altar, lectern and some gold paint touch ups. Congregational approval is needed due to the cost exceeding \$5,000. Information will be in the Bethel Herald. A motion was passed to bring before the congregation for a vote.

**Culver's Fundraising:** This year we will try the program called Share Event at Culvers. It runs from 5-8pm on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesdays. A minimum of 4 adult volunteers are needed as runners, to bus tables, man the Gift Card Recruitment table, ect. Linda will try to secure June 3<sup>rd</sup> or June 10<sup>th</sup>.

Care for Our Neighbor-Haiti: A text from Sue Brown relayed overwhelming gratitude of the happy couple and especially their families still in Haiti! They expressed appreciation for this church as we live out our Christian ideals. Tutoring continues, being rewarding on both sides.
