## Mission Opportunities

**Resurrection Food Pantry** Items specifically needed include: jelly, tuna, baked beans, and especially laundry detergent. Meals in cans are very helpful for the homeless. Please bring only cans, not glass jars. Donations may be placed in the designated basket near the steps going down to fellowship hall.

**NEW Shelter Meal** is on **Sunday, June 8th**. This is a ministry in collaboration with Trinity Lutheran Church, with each church covering the cost of half the lunch. Desserts are needed, please see sign-up on the bulletin board.

**Salvation Army Senior Meal** will be prepared **Monday, July 21st**. This is a spaghetti dinner for seniors 50 and over. The Salvation Army provides the meat and the sauce is prepared by Bethel. Rolls, carrots and desserts are also provided by Bethel. Please see sign-up on the bulletin board for needed items.

**Mission Room** Don't forget that we collect the following items downstairs in the green room.

- Cell phones. Old cell phones will be sent to an organization that recycles the phone for use in domestic violence shelters.
- Christmas Lights will be recycled with the money received being used to offset shipping costs for other recycling.
- Egg Cartons for Paul's Pantry
- Wine corks, The Cork Montados, where cork comes from, is endangered.

**Call to Order:** Cindy called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

**Dwelling in the Word:** Charlie led with a reading Psalm 86, the prayer of David. He offered a prayer for all who are experiencing hard times and challenges.

### REPORTS:

**Secretary's Report:** After one correction it was received as submitted.

**Parish Accountant Report:** Received as submitted.

**Pastor's Report:** Received as submitted. Suggestions that next year on Easter Sunday the council will serve fellowship hour.

### NEW BUSINESS:

**Confirmation:** Hayden Skrobel is approved for confirmation.

**Accounting back up plan:** The council treasurer has a sealed envelope with the online banking passwords in case of an emergency. The council treasurer would also be able to sign checks if needed during an emergency. A person will be trained as a back up to use the online banking and bookkeeping systems.

**Pew-refresh:** June 9<sup>th</sup> date does not work for refinisher. July 7<sup>th</sup> does work. It will be announced on June 29<sup>th</sup> at service that volunteers will be needed after the July 6<sup>th</sup> service to get the sanctuary ready.

**Curtains in Sanctuary:** Replacement is scheduled for June 10<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am.

**EPH:** Thank you to Tim & Nancy Moran for stepping up and becoming unit coordinators for Matthew House, which Bethel supports. They put in many hours getting the house ready for the new family to move in on May 13<sup>th</sup>.

**Feed My Starving Children:** Cindy made a motion to send \$2,700 to Feed My Starving Children from the mission reserve fund. Motion carried.

### OLD BUSINESS:

**Aebleskiver committee update:** There were a good number of people who attended the meeting on May 4<sup>th</sup>. Basket items will be posted and gathered starting in mid-September. In January they will be assembled and February 1<sup>st</sup> displayed.

**Care for our neighbors:** Haitian friends continue to come for English tutoring. Concern for their refugee status was stated and how we could help.

**Resurrection Food Pantry:** Gathered ten huge boxes of food for the Stamp Out Hunger food collection event. It took over 4 hours with many volunteers to sort through the abundance.

**Next meeting, Monday, June 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm.**

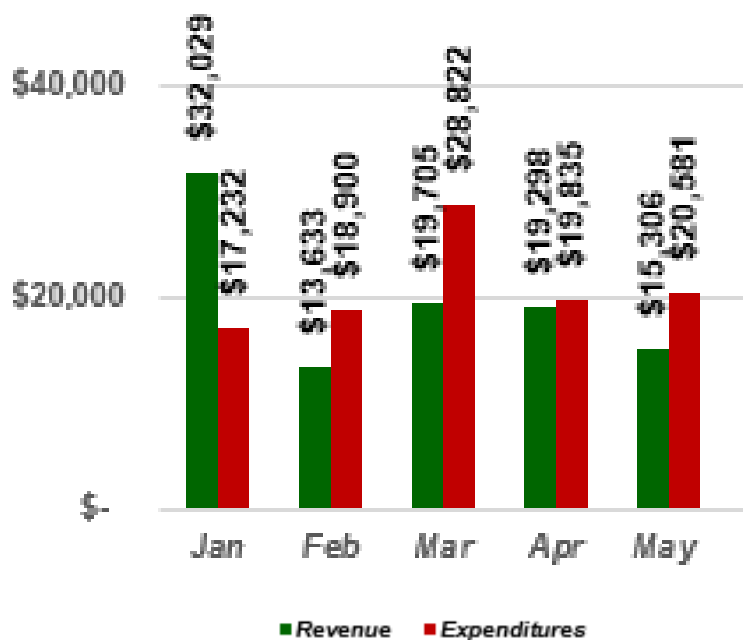
